3 Main Lessons

1.Command to have Taqwa

great principles of Islamic Morality 2. Give Taqwa



it's Haqq

3. Live in Submission



till the end - preserve our Deen while well and safe, so we die & are resurrected as Muslims

How to give Taqwa the Haqq?

- Allah is to be obeyed, not disobeyed
- Allah is remembered and not forgotten
- Show gratitude, and not ingratitude

(statement of Ibn Mas'ud-Hasan al-Basri, Ikrimah, Qatadah, Muqaatil)

LINGUISTICALLY

(وقایہ) from WIQAAYA

فَوَقَاهُمُ اللَّهُ شَرَّ ذَٰلِكَ الْيَوْم

"So Allah will protect them from the evil of that Day" Surah al-Insan : Ayah 11

• Has the meaning of protection & precaution

وَوَقَاهُمْ رَبُّهُمْ عَذَابَ الْجَ

"and their Lord protected them from the punishment of Hellfire." Surah at-Tur : 18

Lisan al-'Arab

"This is the Book about which there is no doubt, a guidance for those conscious of Allah" (Baqarah :2)

Beautiful sayings of Taqwa

Ali (R.A) explained Taqwa:

"The fear of Jaleel (Allah), acting upon the tanzeel (Quran), being content with qaleel (little), and preparing for the day of raheel (journeying from this world)." "The servant cannot reach the true reality of Taqwa unless he gives up whatever wavers the heart"

"Giving up insistence on sins" - Ali ibn Abi Talib r.a.



"Don't do anything which requires your apology!"

Umar al Khattab ra asked Ubayy ibn Ka'b ra about Taqwa:

Ubayy ra. asked "Have you ever taken a thorny path? Umar ra said "Yes, I have'. Ubayy ra then asked "So how did you travel through this thorny path? Umar ra replied "I rolled up my garment and I was cautious as to where I would step to avoid being pricked by the thorns. Ubayy ra responded and said, "This is Taqwa"
