

What your duties as a; muslim, wife, speaker, boss, mother etc.








Mercy for those who believe, even non-muslims use the kalikah to ease the pain for a dying person.

The Qur'an asks, do you not use your intellect?




Learn from their example Don't be like them, or you will end up like them!

Take advice as it is.



Not seeking cure through the Qur'an is like leaving the Qur'an. Muslims thinks its only about recitation, but it is more than that.


Start seeking cure from the Qur'an. Surah al_fatihah is a shifa!




Narrated Aisha:


Whenever Allah's Messenger (became ill, he used to recite the Muawidhatan (i.e. the last two surahs of the Qur'an) and blow his breath over himself (after their recitation) and rubbed his hands over his body. So when he was afflicted with his fatal illness. I started reciting the Muawidhatan and blowing my breath over him as he used to do and then I rubbed the hand of the Prophet (over his body.

QUR'AN GUIDES US TO THE BEST PATH








straight path, on both sides of which are two walls, in which there are open doors, and over the doors are curtains, and at the beginning of the path there is a caller who says: 'O people, enter the. Path all together and do not depart from it. And there is a caller who calls from further in: when a person wants to open any of those doors, he says: Woe to you, do not open it, for if you open it you will enter it. The path is Islam and the walls are the sacred limits of Allah. and the open doors are the things forbidden by Allah. The caller at the beginning of the path is the conscience found in the heart of every muslim." Musnad Ahmad 17634

SOLUTION

Don't be too tied up with your phone, news etc. If you love your phone, open up islamic apps. Don't waste your time on face book, spend more time with the Book of Allah! Listen to advice with your heart.

And this [Qur'an] is a Book We have revealed [which is] blessed, so follow it and fear Allah that you may receive mercy.

Al-An'am, Ayah 155

'Amir b. Wathila reported that Nafi' b. 'Abd al-Harith met 'Umar at 'Usfan and 'Umar had employed him as collector in Mecca. He (Hadrat 'Umar) said to him (Nafi'):

Whom have you appointed as collector over the people of the valley? He said: Ibn Abza. He said: Who is Ibn Abza? He said: He is one of our freed slaves. He (Hadrat 'Umar) said: So you have appointed a freed slave over them. He said: He is well versed In the Book of Allah. the Exalted and Great, and he is well versed In the commandments and injunctions (of the Shari'ah). 'Umar said: So the Prophet () said: By this Book, Allah would exalt some peoples and degrade others. Sahih Muslim 817a

ILM TO ACTION

1. Have a solid plan, recite, understand, memorise, implement and connect with the Qur'an.

Narrated 'Uthman: The Prophet said, "The best among you [muslims] are those who learn the Qur'an and teach it. "Sahih al-Bukhari 5027

2. Try to become the people of Allah

Anas ibn Malik reported: The Messenger of Allah, peace and blessings be upon him, said, "Verily, Allah has His own people among humanity." They said, "O Messenger of Allah, who are they?" The Prophet said, "They are the people of the Quran, the people of Allah and His chosen ones." Source: Sunan Ibn Mājah 215

3. Fullfil the rights of the Qur'an

Narrated `Abdullah bin `Amr:
The Prophet () said, "Convey (my teachings) to the people even if it were a single sentence..."
Sahih al-Bukhari 3461

"...for by Allah, if one man is guided on the right path through you, it would be better for you than [a great number of] red camels. Sahih al-Bukhari 3701

4. Stay happy with the Qur'an and ask Allah for help.
