




The Prophet (s.a.w.) said in his narration of a dream that he saw, "He whose head was being crushed with a stone was one who learnt the Qur'an but never acted on it, and slept ignoring the compulsory prayers." Sahih Bukhari : 1143

#### 6 Conveying - Sharing

The Prophet (s.a.w.) said, "Convey (my teachings) to the people even if it were a single sentence, and tell others the stories of Bani Israel (which have been taught to you), for it is not sinful to do so. And whoever tells alie on me intentionally, will surely take his place in the (Hell) Fire." Sahih Bukhari : 3461

Make Dua to stay connected with the Quran
