Why Do People Cut Ties off?

Abu Huraira reported that a person said: Allah's Messenger, I have relatives with whom I try, to have close relationship, but they sever (this relation). I treat them well, but they treat me ill. I am sweet to them but they are harsh towards me. Upon this he (the Holy Prophet) said: If it is so as you say, then you in fact throw hot ashes (upon their faces) and there would always remain with you on behalf of Allah (an Angel to support you) who would keep you dominant over them so long as d: you adhere to this (path of righteousness).

Not Lawful for us to Desert our Relatives

Narrated Anas bin Malik: Allah's Messenger (صلى الذ عليه وسلم) said, "Do not hate one another, nor be jealous of one another; and do not desert one another, but O Allah's worshipers! Be Brothers! And it is unlawful for a Muslim to desert his brother Muslim (and not to talk to him) for more than three nights." Sahih Bukhari : 6076

Narrated Asma' bint Abu Bakr: My mother came to me during the lifetime of Allah's Messenger (عليه وسلم and she was a pagan. I said to Allah's Apostle (seeking his verdict), "My mother has come to me and she desires to receive a reward from me, shall I keep good relations with her?" The Prophet (على الله عليه وسلم) said, "Yes, keep good relation with her." Sahih Bukhari :2620
