

Ihsaan with spouse

The most complete of the believers in faith. is the one with the best character among them. And the best of you are those who are best to your wives Jami' At-tirmidhi :1162

Parents deserve our Ihsaan the most

And your Lord has decreed that you worship not except Him, and to parents, good treatment. Whether one or both of them reach old age [while] with you. say not to them [so much as], "uff,"1 and do not repel them but speak to them a noble word.

Ihsaan with daughter

There is no man whose two daughters reach the age of puberty and he treats them kindly for the time they are together, but they will gain him admittance to Paradise. Sunan Ibn Majab :3670

On the authority of Abu Huraira who said that the Messenger of Allah (SAW) passed by Abdullah bin Obay bin Salool, while he was in the shade of thick bushes, he said: 'Indeed Ibn Abu Kabshah (the Prophet) has covered us with dust. His son Abdullaah ibn Abdullaah said: 'I swear by The One Who has been generous to you and revealed the Book to you if you want I will bring his head to you.'

Ihsaan with parents no matter who they are

The Prophet(SAW) said: 'No, but rather, be good to your father and maintain good companionship with him." [Silsilah Ahadeeth As-Saheehah: 3223]

Ihsaan with relatives & neighbour

Worship Allah and associate nothing with Him, and to parents do good, and to relatives, orphans, the needu, the near neighbor, the neighbor farther away, the companion at your side, the traveler, and those whom your right hands possess. Indeed, Allah does not like those who are self-deluding and boastful.

An-Nisa: 36

Rasulullah's Wasiyyah: Ihsaan with spouse

And indeed I order you to be good to the women, for they are but captives with you over whom you have no power than that, except if they come with manifest Fahishah (evil behavior). If they do that, then abandon their beds and beat them with a beating that is not harmful. And if they obey you then you have no cause against them. Indeed you have rights over your women, and your women have rights over you. As for your rights over your women, then they must not allow anyone whom you dislike to treat on your bedding (furniture), nor to admit anyone in your home that you dislike. And their rights over you are that you treat them well in clothing them and feeding them.

Ihsaan with animals

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) came upon an emaciated camel and said: Fear Allah regarding these dumb animals. Ride them when they are in good condition and feed them when they are in good condition. Sahih Ahi Daud : 2548

And tell My servants to say that which is best, Indeed, Satan induces [dissension] among them. Indeed Satan is ever, to mankind, a clear enemy Al-Isra: 53

Ihsaan with animals

Abu Darda(RA) had a camel, whose name was ومون. Whenever anyone would want to borrow his camel for some need of his, Abu Darda would sau to him: "Do not burden him with more that what he can bear". When the time for Abu Darda came close (ie death) he said to his camel: "Oh , oo on Day of Qiyamah, do not fight with me (ie hold me responsable) for I only burdened you with that which you could bear(& treated you fairly)

Indeed the most beloved among you to me.& the nearest to sit with me on Day of Judgement is the best of you in character Al-Silsilah as-Saheehah :2/379

Ihsaan in repelling evil

Repel, by [means of] what is best, [their] evil. We are most knowing of what they describe Al-Mukminun: 96

Ihsaan with employees A master of a woman-slave who teaches

her good manners and educates her in the best possible way (the religion) and manumits her and then marries her. For him there is double reward" Sahih Bukhari: 97

Ihsaan with neighbour brings lots of benefit

good manners, and being good to neighbours, will build their abodes and increase their lifespan. Al-silsilah as-Saheehah 519

Forgiveness of past sins

When the time for a prescribed prayer comes, if any Muslim performs ablution well and offers his prayer with humility and bowing, it will be an expiation for his past sins, so long as he has not committed a major sin; and this applies for all times. Sahih Muslim :228
