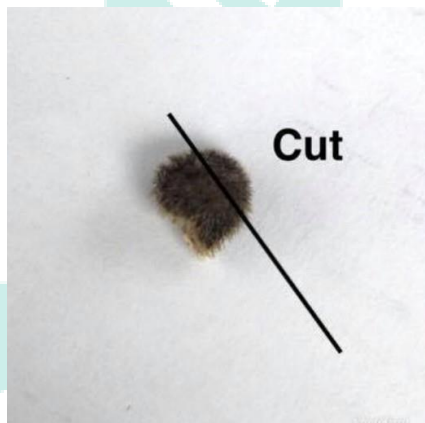


Hibiscus Seeding Proposal Process

1.

Hibiscus seeds have fluff on the outer layer. We need to cut a small hole with a blade to expose the white part (embryo) of the seed. (Please be very careful during this process, do not cut too much to damage the seeds)

2.

Prepare a clean box and an appropriate amount of paper towels. Put the paper towels in the box, and then put the freshly cut seeds.

Add an appropriate amount of water, but do n't add too much, and keep the appropriate humidity on the paper towel (touch the humidity with your hand but do not squeeze out the water.

(Replace the paper towel every 3 to 4 days)

The germination of the seed depends on the temperature, there is a slight difference in length, and it can be put into the soil when the plant grows.

Please cover the seed with 0.5cm medium, and wait for about 7 days to grow.
