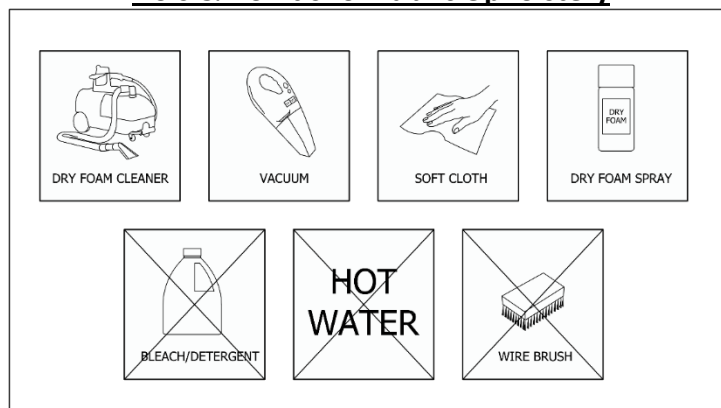

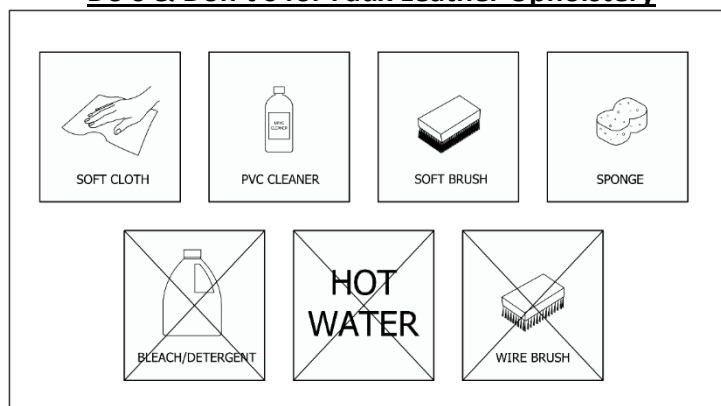
CARE & MAINTENANCE FOR FABRIC & FAUX LEATHER UPHOLSTERY

- Please unpack your chair carefully. Sharp objects can tear your upholstery.
- Be careful to never allow water to build up in frames as this will cause corrosion and freeze damage in cold climates.
- Wipe all frames with a solution of mild soap and water. Rinse with clean water and dry with a soft absorbent non-abrasive cloth.
- For stubborn stains, blot the stains with a damp cloth and a solution of mild soap. Wipe away excess water with a clean non-abrasive cloth. Let the material air-dry fully before use. Never use a commercial or home dryer to tumble dry fabric goods.
- If the stubborn stain has crusted, tap the spot to break up the encrustation and remove as much as possible before using a mild cleaning agent and soft non-abrasive cloth to wipe of the remaining stain.
- Never machine wash cushions covers as this will result in shrinkage or damage.
- Use vacuums to remove any loose crumbs or dirt. Or use a lint roller to gather up any pet fur.
- Do not use bleach, solvents, hot water or wire brush to clean the chair.

CARE & MAINTENANCE FOR MOTOR

- For seats with motors, it is recommended to carry out simple monthly inspection by checking if there is any damage to the main power cable or if there is any sound coming from the seat.

Malfunctioning Seat

- Check if the main plug from the seat is connected to the power socket and it is switched on.
- Check if all main fuses are in good condition and if there is any other electrical appliance operates from the same power socket as the seat.
- If the above steps have been performed and seat is malfunctioning, switch off the main power. Kindly contact the manufacturer (FERCO HOME) or any authorized third (3rd) party seller, at the earliest to report on the issue.

***Warnings:**

- Do not attempt to open any of the electrical components or make any repairs or adjustments to the mechanism of your seat.
- Do not use the seat that is believed to be malfunctioning.
- Do not unplug any cables connecting to the control box before turning off the main power.
