Responsibilities

The Telecommunications Technician ensures high quality installation, maintenance, and operation/performance of the telecommunications systems.

The Telecommunications Technician is responsible for organizing and completing the technical day-to-day operations assigned through work orders and servicing trouble calls.

Install and maintain all aspects of communication systems including wire and cable and equipment. Provides technical system support and capabilities including, but not limited to installation, maintenance, modification and repair of telecommunications equipment, products and/or systems. Technical systems may be electro-mechanical or computerized and are typically integrated with or interconnected to larger systems. Incumbents typically perform work on-site, off-site, or at remote locations and can be expected to apply troubleshooting and diagnostic techniques to determine appropriate restoration or repair actions.

QUALIFICATION

SPM (Vocational) / Diploma. Emphasis in Telecommunications or Electronics is preferred.

WORKING EXPERIENCE

For those with SPM or the equivalent, at least (4) four years of experience with either the installation or cable plant PREFERRED.

For those with Degree with an emphasis in Telecommunications or Electronics, (2) two years of related work experience providing an in-depth knowledge of installation and maintenance of telecommunications equipment and inside cable plant design and installation is required.
